### 1. Background of Smart City

- Rapid Increase of Global Urban Problem**
  - According to the UN reports, global population is expected to reach approx. 9 billion in 2050 and approx.67% of the population is expected to be residing in the urban environment (UN, 2014)
- Urban Problems**
- Increasing Concern for Global Climate Change**
  - To cope with climate change effectively, developed countries, especially those in Europe presented the smart city as a means to solve such problems
- Climate Change**

### 1. Background of Smart City

- "Smart" is the keyword of the 21st Century**
  - Smart City that Exploit Information and Communication Technologies are employed by
- (1) developing countries for domestic economic invigoration and solution to anticipated urban problems caused by the rapid increase of urban population
- (2) developed countries for sustainability in the backdrop of global climatic change

The size of Smart City Global Market is forecasted to rapidly increase from 400 billion USD in 2014 to 1.1 trillion USD in 2019 (MarketsandMarkets, 2015)

### 1. Background of Smart City

- Ways of Solving urban problems in Smart City**
  - Smart Cities approach the maximization of urban infrastructure and utilization of financial resources by providing citizens with appropriate real-time information

Ways of Problem Solving in Smart Cities (Example)		
Urban Problem	Current City	Smart City
Traffic Jam	Expansion of Roads	Provision of bypass Information
Increase of Crimes	Increase of Police Force	Real-time monitoring via CCTV
Rapid Increase of Electric Consumption	Expansion of Power Plant	Provision of Real-Time Information of Electrical Charges

### 1. Background of Smart City

- The Concept of Smart City**
  - Smart City is usually defined as "a city enabled to solve urban problems through the exploitation of ICT (Information & Communication Technology) or as a sustainable city enabled to improve the level of urban competitiveness and quality of life".

### 1. Physical Space and Cyber Space

- Physical Space vs Cyber Space**
  - Both Physical Space and Cyber Space are necessary to be considered together for Better Smart City Planning

- 사우디아라비아 정부의 각 관련 부처들이 적극적으로 참여하는 등 사우디아라비아 스마트도시 프로젝트 추진여부에 대한 관심이 매우 높음

## 2. MOMRA와 사우디 정부 스마트시티 프로젝트 논의

- 사우디아라비아 정부는 스마트도시 구축에 매우 관심이 높으며 현재 1단계 사업으로 스마트도시 구축 타당성에 대한 검토를 수행 중에 있음
- 인도 등의 스마트도시 프로젝트 추진과 유사하게 현재 사우디아라비아에서는 스마트도시 추진에 대한 확실한 방향이 존재하지 않음
  - 특히, 스마트도시와 기존 도시계획 측면을 연계시키는 것에 많은 관심이 있지만 실제 추진을 어떻게 할 것인지에 대하여 여전히 논의 중에 있음
  - 정보통신기술적 측면은 글로벌 기업인 IDC에서 지원 중에 있으며 IDC에서는 사우디아라비아에 적합한 솔루션 논의 보다 보편적 솔루션에 대한 논의를 위주
  - 반면, 스마트도시 법 및 향후 스마트도시 지표 수립에 대한 관심은 높음
- 1차적으로 타당성 검토 후 2단계에서는 17개 도시에 대한 시범사업, 3단계에서는 스마트도시 확산을 계획하고 있음
  - 향후 2단계 사업이 확정될 것인지에 대한 지속적 모니터링과 2단계 사업 확정 시 사업에 참여할 수 있는 방안 모색이 필요
