

MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION  
BETWEEN

THE KOREA RESEARCH INSTITUTE FOR HUMAN SETTLEMENTS  
AND  
THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR LAND AND INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT

The Korea Research Institute for Human Settlements (hereinafter, "KRIHS") and the National Institute for Land and Infrastructure Management (hereinafter, "NILIM") have come to reach the following statement to pursue an agenda of international cooperation of both institutes.

KHRIS and NILIM have confirmed that it is in their best interests to encourage direct contacts and cooperation between their institute members, departments, and research centers focused on Planning and Management Technologies on Land, Infrastructure and Housing.

Priority for the near term should be given on the field of urban policies. In order to pursue the mutual benefit based on the framework of partnership, both KRIHS and NILIM intend to explore the following general forms of cooperation:

1. Joint workshop, seminar and conference activities
2. Joint research and publication activities
3. Cooperation for the field surveys in both countries
4. Exchange of data and other information relevant to the interests of KRIHS and NILIM
5. Exchange of staff at both institutes for the purpose of facilitating their surveys, researches

This memorandum will commence upon the date of signature by appropriate representatives of KRIHS and NILIM and will be reviewed and automatically extended every five years. These activities will be subject to the availability of funding and other resources, plus the development of specific arrangements. Further specific activities will be discussed.
